



Call for Posters for the 1st GISTT Summit

Oct 16th-18th 2024 in Essen, Germany

Posters provide the most unique opportunity to interact with other researchers – more so than with a platform presentation. It is through well organized poster sessions that we, as organizers, have received encouragement, new ideas and long-lasting connections in our early career.

Format

Ideally, a scientific meeting is a safe space, where you can show work in progress but more importantly share struggles, pitch ideas and get input from peers who complement that work. For the GISTT summit, we would like to make posters one of the central elements of the meeting. We are encouraging new formats which challenge traditional conference layouts. We have drafted a poster template that provides a few ideas of how posters could be more engaging and intriguing. However, we also appreciate if you would like to use a more traditional format or something completely different – particularly if it is creative.

Special Call

Some of you may have also run into a dead-end with a project – we call these projects “dead horses”. Most of the time, it is good to get off these horses and move on. Sometimes there is the situation where we feel there is life and meaning to it, but we need input to get it up and running to the finish line. So we will offer a “seemingly dead horse” corner... Just in case.

Poster Pitches

We hope that many posters complement the platform sessions that we have drafted with many leaders of the field. We would like to offer younger scientists an opportunity to give a very brief power pitch at the end of these sessions. Given the time constraints we won't be able to offer all poster presenters an opportunity to pitch, but the selection will be aimed at thematic relationships. Every poster is important!
